



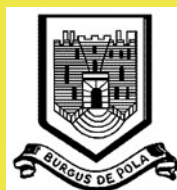

1.3 Event Overview

The event format for 2012 remains very similar to that of the 2011 event with the addition of two stages on the Friday evening for the The Bulldog International Rally of North Wales and The Bulldog Production Rally.

All the rallies making up the event will be based at Welshpool Livestock Sales on the eastern outskirts of the town at Buttington Cross.

The event will be a thorough examination of the rallying skills of competitors in the world class special stages of the forests of North Wales. These combined with the notoriously unpredictable weather ensure that the compact event will be a challenge for any crew wanting to progress the 2012 season with a maximum points score.

The shakedown stage run on Thursday will be booked on a first come, first served basis for the limited number of places and this year will again be run by PEC.

Scrutineering for International competitors will be on Friday morning and documentation checks for International crews will be combined with reconnaissance signing-on in Welshpool on Thursday evening. Reconnaissance is for the International Rally competitors only and will take place on Friday. Documentation for those not taking part in the reconnaissance will be carried out at the Welshpool base on Friday afternoon.

Scrutineering and Documentation for Historic, Challenge, National and Production events will be on Friday afternoon although a small number of Challenge and National Rally competitors may elect to be inspected early on Saturday by appointment.

Any crew member having difficulties in complying with the pre-event timetable should discuss these with the organisers. As soon as possible.

The Bulldog International Rally of North Wales and the Bulldog Production Rally will start on Friday evening. Both events will complete leg 1 on Friday evening and be placed in parc ferme over night. The events will restart at Welshpool Livestock Sales on Saturday Morning and finish on Saturday in Welshpool Town centre. The Production event will be combined with the National event on the Saturday.

The Historic, Challenge and National Rallies will have a ceremonial start in Welshpool Town Centre on Friday evening. The competitive start and finish will be at Welshpool Livestock Sales site on Saturday and have a ceremonial finish in Welshpool Town Centre.

Servicing for the International will be carried out at the Welshpool Livestock Sales with a remote service area at Dolgellau.

Servicing for the Challenge and Production events will be based at Dolgellau to reduce the number of road miles in the liaison sections.

Servicing for the Historic and National Rallies will be based at Dolgellau on Saturday.

Prize giving for the International, Challenge and Production crews will take place on the finish podium as the rally finishes. The Historic and National Rallies will each have a separate prize-giving ceremony inside the main building of Welshpool Livestock Sales following the finalisation of the results of the relevant event.

Post event scrutineering will take place in Welshpool town.



1.4 Welshpool

Welshpool is situated in the upper reaches of the picturesque Severn Valley near the border between Wales and England. The bustling market town is surrounded by the rolling hills of Montgomeryshire and the glorious unspoilt countryside of Mid-Wales. Traditionally an agricultural centre, Welshpool possesses the largest sheep market in Europe and the feeling of a traditional hard working market town still remains today.

Welshpool has a long and colourful past and many features and buildings of historical value remain. A unique blend of shops offers the opportunity to pick up items difficult to find elsewhere; from arts & crafts to fashion & leisure, fresh food & wine and lots more. Quality local produce is on display in shops, reflecting Welshpool's role as the centre of an agricultural community, promoting local crafts and items of a Welsh flavour.

Wales has a temperate climate although it is generally slightly cloudier and wetter than England due to its hilly and mountainous terrain coupled with its proximity to the Atlantic. However being situated on the western side of the UK it is influenced by the gulf stream bringing milder conditions than would normally be associated with a country on this latitude. Being situated on the western extreme of the European continent weather conditions can vary considerably from week to week and sometimes from day to day. Snow is common on higher ground during the winter but many lower lying and coastal regions only experience snow for a few days each year.

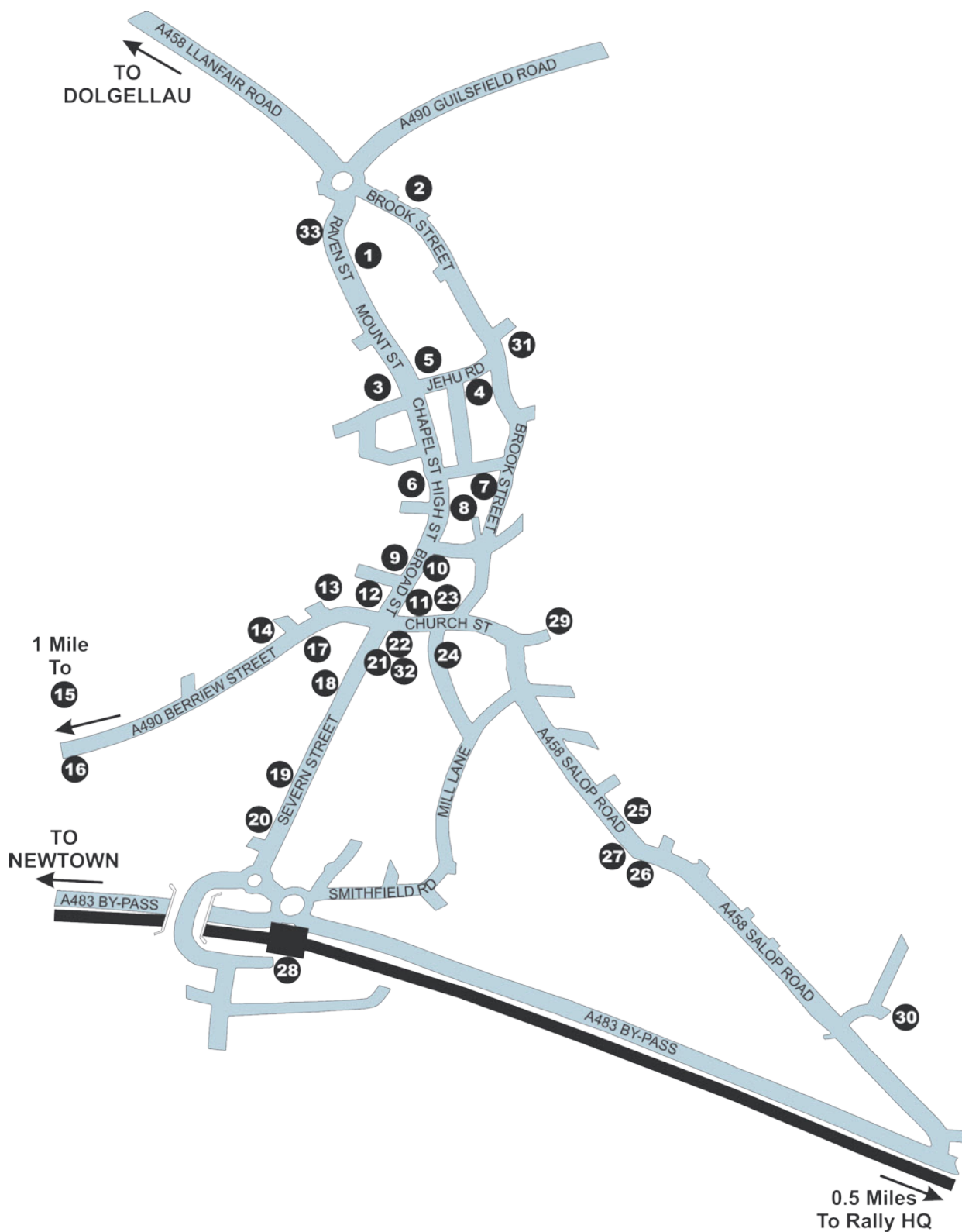


APPENDIX 2 - UK Locations Map
